Pinnacles

April 10-13

Climbing at Pinnacles is truly an adventure. The rock ranges from mud like to incredibly sound. This produces routes of the highest calibre. The rock is volcanic, with many protruding knobs and pebbles that allow ascents of many vertical to overhanging faces. Most routes are short-around 80 feet or under.

Sandstone spires are located among the canyons and hills on the western slope of one of the Bay Area's highest peaks, Mt Diablo. The rock varies from sandy and loose to hard and polished. It offers both top roping and leading on faces up to 90 feet high. This trip provides the perfect opportunity to learn important climbing procedures and technique.

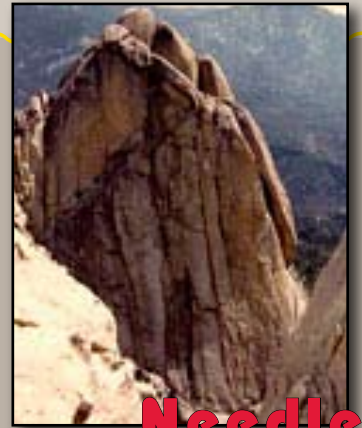


Yosemite
